

<b>Goal:</b>	To provide Drexel medical students interested in Neurosurgery the opportunity to conduct Neurosurgery research for a year and clinical and operative exposure to the field.	The Scholars Program is a longitudinal experience of guided study for exploration of medical practice, education or research. It consists of a series of research activities throughout the four years of medical school.
